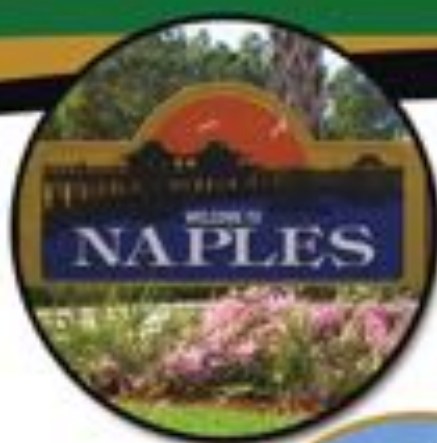


The Willough Healthcare System

### DUAL DIAGNOSIS AND ADDICTIVE TREATMENT SERVICES

The dual diagnosis and addictive treatment programs provide detoxification, education, and treatment services for persons 18 years of age and older. Detoxification services are closely monitored and managed by a skilled team of physicians and nurses. The length of time a patient receives detoxification services varies depending upon a number of factors. Once detoxification services are safely completed, you along with your attending psychiatrist and treatment team will determine your treatment goals and ways of accomplishing them. In meeting your goals, services are arranged around a structured daily program schedule.
